

# MASSACHUSETTS DESTINATION IMAGINATION

## CODE OF CONDUCT

The goals of this code of conduct are to ensure that:

- All MADI tournaments are a **positive, safe and fun** experience for ALL.
- Every school that volunteers to host our program feels that we left their building in better shape than we found it.
- Each teacher and administrator whose space we use feels we respect their space and are grateful for its use.

### **Expected and Required Conduct:**

1. Adults must supervise all minors in attendance whether on a team or not.
2. Any posted "off limits" areas inside or outside a school must be respected by all. Penalties or team disqualification will ensue if anyone is found in "off limits" areas.
3. Respect all property, including lockers, displays, classrooms, etc.
4. Food will only be allowed in designated areas (cafeterias) as posted. No food or drinks will be allowed at sites or prop areas.
5. Prop areas are designated as storage areas only. No major repairs, painting, use of glue guns, power tools, or anything that could damage the area will be allowed.
6. Make up must be carefully applied and removed without staining rugs, floors and walls.
7. No ball playing allowed within the building. Nothing may be tossed or thrown.
8. No one may run, climb or rough house within a building. Any conduct considered unsafe will not be tolerated.
9. Unsportsmanlike conduct by anyone connected to a team will cause that team to receive a penalty. We hope **everyone** attending the tournaments will create an environment in accordance with our MADI philosophy. This prohibits rudeness, name-calling, insulting a team or individual(s), profanity, or asking others about their scores.
10. Teams will be held accountable for their behavior and the behavior of anyone connected with their team - siblings, friends, family, adults, and supporters. PLEASE be sure everyone attending the tournament knows these rules and understands their behavior will impact a team.

**Our tournaments must be a positive, safe and fun experience for all.**

**Host schools must feel that we left their facility in better shape than we found it.**

**We want every teacher and administrator to feel that we are grateful for the use of their space.**

**This Code of Conduct will be in effect at all Massachusetts Destination Imagination tournaments. We agree to abide by this Code of Conduct and we understand the consequences of violating the rules.**
